To mature in our walk with Christ, we want to see growth in our abiding relationship with Christ, in our homes, in our church life, and in our relationships with our neighbors and coworkers! To do that, we need to talk about a few key areas:

4 TOPICS OF DISCUSSION

1) Habits

Starting and maintaining the habits of reading the Bible and praying with our Father.

We want the desires of our heart to be centered on God. And if we are aiming for growth in our mutual ministry time, the habit of “feeding ourselves” is foundational to any maturation we want to see spiritually or relationally. You can’t grow without nourishment! And the Lord is where we find all of our wisdom for growth, but also our satisfaction and joy! So we commit to find joy in our time with the Father with the plan of being transformed by that time too.

“Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.” (John 15:4)

2) Celebrating God’s Works

Sharing how God’s been encouraging you lately.

We’ll experience a lot of growth, encouragement, and joy when we have our eyes opened to the Lord’s work. But sometimes we have to be reminded to be looking for God. Or our hearts may even be deceived into thinking he isn’t present or working at all! We fight this by developing the habit of looking for and recognizing God at work.

“In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.” (Proverbs 3:6)

3) Spiritual and Relational Goals

Setting up self-identified targets for personal growth spiritually and relationally (Abiding, Home, Church, and Neighbor).

We see our maturity play itself out in two primary relationships—our relationship with God and relationship with others. You may fall into one of two camps when it comes to your spiritual life and relationships: (1) you want to grow but don’t know how or (2) you know how you want to grow but don’t have a game plan to achieve it. We want to set goals for ourselves and then chase after those goals as a group so we can grow up into Christ! We’ll be specific about where we are, where we want to be, and how we’re going to get there!

“Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ...” (Ephesians 4:15)

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.” (Galatians 5:22-23)

4) Prayer

Passionately praying over each person at every meeting.

The joy of praying will not only be a core part of our time together, but we will strive to pray for every single person in every one of our meetings. We want you to be able to count on the fact that you will be prayed for and get to pray over someone else at every single meeting!

“Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints.” (Ephesians 6:18)
